Subject: Designates the Lance Corporal James Sprowl Memorial Highway

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in costs for producing and installing a set of memorial signs for this memorial highway. Specifically, the bill designates the stretch of State Route 99 between the intersections of the route with County Road 64 and County Road 119 within Huron County as the Lance Corporal James Sprowl Memorial Highway. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
