## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"James H. Hough Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The southbound lane of I-71, commencing at mile marker 102 and proceeding to mile marker 100, in Franklin County
