Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

Sub. H.B. 139

132nd General Assembly
(S. Government Oversight and Reform)

Makes nonpublic records generally available to the public 75 years, instead of 100 years, after they are created.

Exempts from disclosure after 75 years under the bill any security and infrastructure records that are exempt from release or disclosure under continuing law.

Removes a provision of the bill that would have exempted from the Public Records Act records that are confidential under laws under which a public office functions, in addition to records that are confidential under state or federal law.
