- Designates July 16 as "National Atomic Veterans Day" in Ohio.

## CONTENT AND OPERATION

<b>Subject</b>	National Atomic Veterans Day in Ohio <sup>1</sup>
<b>Designation</b>	July 16
<b>Other information</b>	The act specifies that the designation is to raise awareness of the health issues many atomic veterans suffer as a result of their service and sacrifice. An "atomic veteran" is a military veteran who is presumed to have been exposed to radiation during the time of service.
