## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

License Plate	<b>Fallen Timbers Battlefield</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by representatives of the Fallen Timbers Battlefield Preservation Commission and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	<ul> <li>\$20 required contribution.</li> <li>\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.</li> <li>Contributions must be paid to the Fallen Timbers Battlefield Preservation Commission, which must use the contributions to further the Commission's mission.<sup>2</sup></li> </ul>
Requirements for Issuance	<ol> <li>Submission of an application;</li> <li>Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol>

Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. <sup>3</sup>
