## **SUMMARY**

Requires the Medicaid program and health benefit plans to reimburse Ohio-licensed dentists for personal protective equipment.

## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill requires the Medicaid program and a health benefit plan (a contract offered by a health plan issuer to provide for or pay for health care services, including a plan offered by a health insuring corporation, sickness and accident insurer, public employee benefit plan, multiple employer welfare arrangement, or fraternal benefit society) that provides coverage for dental care services to reimburse Ohio-licensed dentists for personal protective equipment (safety equipment that is necessary to provide those services with minimal risk of disease transmission). The bill requires the reimbursement to be a standard fee made on a per date of service, per patient basis.<sup>1</sup>
