Prohibitions related to the sale of cigarettes

Removes provisions that did the following:

- Prohibit a wholesaler from recklessly offering or giving a concession in connection with the sale of cigarettes with the intent to inhibit competition.
- Prohibit a retailer from purposely inducing, procuring, or attempting to induce or procure the purchase of cigarettes at a price that, including any related concessions, is less than the statutory minimum wholesale price.
