### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Army Sergeant Patrick Ryan Carroll Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	State Route 162, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between Fitchville and the boundary of New London, in Huron County
<b>Other Information</b>	Army Sergeant Patrick Ryan Carroll died in Kandahar province, Afghanistan, of wounds sustained when insurgents attacked his unit with an improvised explosive device. He was assigned to the 319 <sup>th</sup> Military Intelligence Battalion, Fort Bragg, N.C.
