Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_134_1010-2)
ABLE Committee	
No provision.	Creates the Antiquated and Biased Language Elimination (ABLE) Committee to examine the terminology used in the Revised Code related to aging, crime victims, disabilities, and mental health.
	Requires the ABLE Committee to identify outdated terminology and make recommendations for replacement terminology.
	Requires the member appointed by the Director of Developmental Disabilities to convene two meetings of the Committee and prepare a report of its recommendations within six months after the bill's effective date.
	(Section 2.)
