Nurse aide training

Allows a nurse aide to satisfy the existing requirement to complete a training and competency evaluation program by completing at least 75 hours of training in a long-term care setting during the COVID-19 public health emergency. This training must include on-site observation and work as a nurse aide under a COVID-19 pandemic waiver issued by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, and address all of the required areas specified in federal law.

Requires that prospective nurse aides using this new training pathway successfully complete the competency evaluation conducted by the Director of Health.
