This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.¹

Memorial highways and bridges	
Designates a portion of S.R. 86, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction, between mile marker number four and mile marker number seven, in Leroy Township in Lake County as "Staff Sgt. Kyle R. McKee Memorial Highway" (R.C. 5534.604).	Instead, designates all of S.R. 86 between the eastern and western borders of Leroy Township in Lake County as "SSG Kyle R. McKee Memorial Highway" (R.C. 5534.604).

¹ As used in the table: "I" means Interstate Route, "S.R." means State Route, and "U.S.R." means U.S. Route.
