The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. It requires a separately metered, noncommercial structure on a retail electric customer's property be charged for electricity at the same rate as the customer's primary residence.

### Synopsis of Fiscal Effect Changes

- The bill's fiscal effects remain unchanged under the substitute bill.
- The substitute bill allows any number of separately metered, noncommercial structures on a retail electric customer's property to be charged at that primary residence rate.
