### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Robert E. Turney Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of U.S. Route 36 between County Road 62 and County Road 416, in Tuscarawas County.

### COMMENT

Robert E. Turney served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was awarded the Silver Star for his actions during the North Africa campaign in 1943, where he remained with a wounded soldier, even though remaining resulted in both being captured. Remarkably, they were released after a few days. After returning home after the war, he worked for the Ohio Department of Transportation from 1945 to 1978, and passed away on October 15, 1989.
