## Bill Analysis

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Patrolman David L. Cole Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of I-71, between Martin Luther King Drive and Eden Park Drive, in Hamilton County.
<b>Other Information</b>	Patrolman David L. Cole was shot and killed in the line of duty on July 17, 1974, after responding to a call about a burglary of a local business. He served five years with the Cincinnati Police Department.
