### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Deputy Sheriff Matthew Yates Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 40, between Tuttle Road and State Route 54, in Clark County.
<b>Other Information</b>	Deputy Yates served with the Clark County Sheriff's Office for 15 years before he was shot and killed on duty while responding to reports of gunfire.
