### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Wayne County Gold Star Family Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The portion of State Route (S.R.) 226, between S.R. 514 and where S.R. 226 passes Triway High School, in Wayne county.
<b>Other Information</b>	Gold Star Families are the families of those who lost their lives while serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. The term originated during World War I when families displayed small banners with a blue star for every immediate family member serving in the military. The blue star was replaced with a gold star if that family member died or was killed in action while serving.
