## Bill Analysis

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"TSgt. Grover Lee Swearingen Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 41, between the municipal corporations of Peebles and West Union, in Adams County.
<b>Other Information</b>	TSgt. Grover Lee Swearingen served in the U.S. Army Air Force during World War II. His plane was shot down over Dusseldorf, Germany, and he was held as a prisoner of war there for nine months. He returned home to West Union, Ohio and served his community until his death on October 21, 2021.
