### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"John Lennon Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 87 between Bundysburg Road and Madison Road, in Geauga County
<b>Other Information</b>	John Lennon was the President of Abbott Valve and Fitting, Co. and a foreman on the Cuyahoga County Grand Jury. He was an avid philanthropist and supporter of local police and fire departments – having made significant contributions for shooting ranges, fitness centers, K-9 dogs, and support vehicles and equipment. He passed away on February 24, 2024.
