## S.B. 104 of the 135<sup>th</sup> General Assembly

## Single-sex facilities and accommodations

- Requires public and chartered nonpublic schools, educational service centers (ESCs), and
  institutions of higher education to designate specified facilities for the exclusive use of
  students of either the male biological sex or the female biological sex.
- Prohibits schools and ESCs from permitting biological females to use a student restroom, locker room, changing room, or shower room that is designated for biological males and vice versa.
- Prohibits institutions of higher education from knowingly permitting biological females to use a student restroom, locker room, changing room, or shower room that is designated for biological males and vice versa.
- Prohibits schools and ESCs from permitting members of the female biological sex to share overnight accommodations with members of the male biological sex.
- Entitles the provisions described above as the "Protect All Students Act."
