### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"U.S. Army Private First Class Jerry Bockbrader Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	State Route (S.R.) 199 between West South Boundary Street and S.R. 105 in Wood County
<b>Other Information</b>	PFC Bockbrader was killed by communist forces on September 18, 1967, in Thua Thien Province, Republic of South Vietnam. PFC Bockbrader was investigating a suspicious person when he was killed by an explosion from an enemy grenade.
