### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"SSG Jack W. Coy Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	Northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 280 between Navarre Avenue and Front Street, in Lucas County
<b>Other Information</b>	SSG Jack W. Coy served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. He was killed in action on February 24, 1944, when his plane was shot down over Germany.
