### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	“Sgt. Anthony Kress Vinnedge Memorial Highway” <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 129 between Chapel Road and the border of Indiana, in Butler County
<b>Other Information</b>	Army Sgt. Vinnedge served during Operation Iraqi Freedom. On July 5, 2007, he died in Iraq from injuries related to a noncombat incident.
