Admission procedures		
Requires each chartered nonpublic school that enrolls EdChoice and Cleveland scholarship students to include in its admission procedure a method to determine which students to admit if the number of applicants for a grade level, school building, or education program exceeds the school's capacity (R.C. 3301.165(B)). Requires each school to report its method for admission determinations to the Department of Education and Workforce (R.C. 3301.165(B)).	No provision.	

Data reporting

Requires each qualifying chartered nonpublic school to annually report to the Department all of the following:

 The school's total enrollment and its capacity limits by grade level, school building, and education program; and Requires the Department to annually post on its publicly accessible website all of the following for each chartered nonpublic school:

- 1. The school's total enrollment;
- 2. The number of EdChoice, Cleveland, Jon Peterson, and Autism scholarship students enrolled in the school,

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- The number of EdChoice and Cleveland scholarship students enrolled in the school, disaggregated by whether, in the prior school year, the students were enrolled in one of the following:
 - a. That school;
 - b. A different chartered nonpublic school;
 - c. A nonchartered nonpublic school;
 - d. A city, local, or exempted village school district;
 - e. A community school;
 - f. A STEM school; or
 - g. If the student was not enrolled in a school in the prior school year, whether the student was exempted from attendance at school for the purpose of home education in that year or the student is enrolling in school in Ohio for the first time in the current school year (R.C. 3301.165(C)).

Latest Version (I_135_3070-4)

disaggregated by whether, in the prior school year, the students were enrolled in one of the following:

- a. That school;
- b. A different chartered nonpublic school;
- c. A nonchartered nonpublic school;
- d. A city, local, or exempted village school district;
- e. A community school;
- f. A STEM school; or
- g. If the student was not enrolled in a school in the prior school year, whether the student was exempted from attendance at school for the purpose of home education in that year or the student is enrolling in school in Ohio for the first time in the current school year.
- 3. The total amount of state support received by the school through all of the following:
 - a. State scholarship programs;
 - b. Auxiliary services payments; and
 - c. Administrative cost reimbursements (R.C. 3301.165(D)).

Requires the Department to require each EdChoice scholarship applicant to include the school, and if applicable the school district, in which the applicant is enrolled, or that the student is receiving home education, for the school year prior to the one for which the applicant is submitting an application (R.C. 3310.16(E)).

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Chartered nonpublic school report card		
Requires the Department to establish a report card for qualifying chartered nonpublic schools (R.C. 3302.0311).	Requires the Department to establish a report card that measures the performance of students enrolled in chartered nonpublic schools under a state scholarship program and to consult with its state advisory committee on chartered nonpublic schools in establishing that report card (R.C. 3302.0311).	
Requires the Department to include in the report card issued for a qualifying chartered nonpublic school the school's report regarding its total enrollment and the number of EdChoice and Cleveland scholarship students enrolled in it (R.C. 3302.0311).	No provision.	

Family income of students receiving an SGO scholarship

Requires the Department to annually publish on its website aggregate data that includes the family income of each EdChoice scholarship recipient attending a chartered nonpublic school for whom a scholarship from a scholarship granting organization (SGO) is used to pay for remaining tuition and fees (R.C. 3310.13(F)).

Requires the Department of Education and Workforce to request from the Department of Taxation any data necessary to report aggregate family income data (R.C. 3310.13(F)).
