### DETAILED ANALYSIS

<b>License Plate</b>	<b>Weirdo Cat Lovers of Cleveland</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by representatives of the nonprofit organization Weirdo Cat Lovers of Cleveland and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
<b>Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution</b>	\$15 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to the Weirdo Cat Lovers of Cleveland, which must use the funds to further the organization's mission of assisting pet parents with emergency veterinary bills for their feline companions, providing food and litter to those in economic need, and controlling feral cat populations through the process of trap-neuter-return to the community. <sup>2</sup>
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	1. Submission of an application; 2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and

	3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
