DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Chief Ronald A. Brown Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northeastbound and southwestbound lanes of State Route 16 between West Carlisle Road and Old Riley Road, in Muskingum County
Other Information	Chief Ronald A. Brown had over 40 years of law enforcement experience with different agencies before retiring from the Clinton Township Police Department. He died on March 6, 2021, after battling cancer.
