S.B. 210 (As Passed by the Senate)	Latest Version (I_135_3099)
Special Designations	
No provision.	Designates April 18 as "Devo Day," in honor of the new wave band Devo from Akron. (R.C. 5.2539).
No provision.	Designates October 10 ^h as "Black Brewers Day." (R.C. 5.266).
No provision.	Designates April as "Arab American Heritage Month." (R.C. 5.267).
No provision.	Designates March 8 as "International Women's Day" in Ohio. (R.C. 5.54).
No provision.	Designates March as "Women's History Month." (R.C. 5.56).
No provision.	Designates June 20 as "World Refugee Day." (R.C. 5.57).
No provision.	Designates October as "Hindu Heritage Month." (R.C. 5.58).

S.B. 210 (As Passed by the Senate)	Latest Version (I_135_3099)
Thin Blue Line Flags	
No provision.	Prohibits manufactured home park operators and landlords from including a restriction in a rental agreement or otherwise prohibiting the display of a thin blue line flag or emblem. (R.C. 4781.40 and 5321.131).
No provision.	Prohibits neighborhood, civic, homeowners, and condominium associations from including a provision in a governing document that prohibits the display of a thin blue line flag or emblem, subject to specified conditions. (R.C. 5301.072 and 5311.191).
No provision.	Names these sections of the bill after Police Chief Steven DiSario. (Section 3 of the bill).
