Synopsis of House Committee Amendments

(This synopsis does not address amendments that may have been adopted on the House Floor.)

S.B. 198 of the 135th General Assembly

House State and Local Government

Citizenship for participation

Requires the state identification card and employment document assistance programs, created by the bill, to be used by DRC and DYS for prisoners and youth who are U.S. citizens only. (R.C. 4507.50, 5120.59, 5139.511, and 5145.1611)

Local jail funding

- For local jail facility projects, retroactively makes the currently required state's portion of the basic project cost a minimum amount, (e.g., if the state's portion under current law is 80%, the state's portion under the amendment would be a minimum of 80%, and the state could elect to provide a greater amount. Continuing law provides the state's portion cannot fall below 25%.)
- Retroactively allows DRC to establish guidelines for multicounty project applications. (Section 383.10 of H.B. 33 of the 135th General Assembly; Section 6)
