DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "PFC John Wayne Richard Memorial Highway" ¹ |

| Highway | Northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 47 between McGreevey Road and Long Road in Darke County |
| Other Information | PFC John Wayne Richard served in the United States Army in South Vietnam during the Vietnam War. He was killed while fighting communist forces on May 21, 1969. |
