The table above summarizes details about the highway designated by the bill, including the location and the entity responsible for installing the signs. The cost of producing and installing signs is approximately \$1,400. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) produces the signs and is often responsible for the installation. However, if the highway is located within municipal boundaries, as is the case with this bill, the municipality may install the signs and may need to reimburse ODOT for the production costs. At its north end in Ohio, U.S. Route 24 runs through Toledo.
