BILL SUMMARY

• Authorizes the owner or lessee of a motorcycle to apply to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles for a "Breast Cancer Awareness" license plate.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Breast Cancer Awareness" license plates

The bill authorizes the owner or lessee of a motorcycle to apply to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles for the issuance of a "Breast Cancer Awareness" license plate. Current law does not specifically mention owners or lessees of motorcycles under the class of people that may apply for "Breast Cancer Awareness" license plates.¹
