BILL SUMMARY

- Requires each state institution of higher education to develop a plan to reduce in-state student cost of attendance by 5% for the 2016-2017 academic year.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill requires the board of trustees of each state institution of higher education to prepare a plan to reduce student cost of attendance for all in-state students by 5% for the 2016-2017 academic year. The plans must be submitted to the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents by September 1, 2015.¹

As used in the bill, "state institution of higher education" means the University of Akron, Bowling Green State University, Central State University, University of Cincinnati, Cleveland State University, Kent State University, Miami University, Ohio University, Ohio State University, Shawnee State University, University of Toledo, Wright State University, Youngstown State University, and the Northeast Ohio Medical University and any community college, state community college, university branch, or technical college.²
