BILL SUMMARY

- Requires each state institution of higher education to require entrepreneurial skills education as a condition of receiving a diploma for a graduate degree in a professional degree program, such as law, medicine, or engineering.
- Requires the Chancellor of the Board of Regents to adopt rules to implement the bill's provisions.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill requires each state institution of higher education to require entrepreneurial skills education as a condition of receiving a diploma for a graduate degree in a professional degree program, such as law, medicine, or engineering, so that students will have business skills along with their professional training when they graduate. It also requires the Chancellor of the Board of Regents to adopt rules to implement the bill's provisions.¹
