- Designates the tenth day of November as "Armed Services, Peace Officer, First Responder, and Dual Service Recognition Day."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Armed Services, Peace Officer, First Responder, and Dual Service Recognition Day

The bill designates the tenth day of November as "Armed Services, Peace Officer, First Responder, and Dual Service Recognition Day" to recognize and honor, as twice the servants, individuals who have served in the armed forces and also have served as a police officer or other first responder.
