BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of U.S. Route 33, commencing at the intersection of East Livingston Avenue and College Avenue in Columbus and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of U.S. Route 33 and State Route 104, as the "John W. Bowen Memorial Roadway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway indicating its name.¹

John W.E. Bowen III was the first African American from Franklin County to serve as a member of the Ohio Senate.
