CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following memorial highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Memorial Highway
The "Army Chief Warrant Officer Donald V. Clark Memorial Highway" (<i>R.C. 5534.25</i>)	A portion of State Route 7, commencing at its intersection with the road known as West Western Reserve Road to the west of S.R. 7 and as East Western Reserve Road to the east of S.R. 7 and proceeding in a northerly direction to its intersection with U.S. Route 224, within Mahoning County only.

Army Chief Warrant Officer Donald V. Clark was killed in a helicopter crash on November 15, 2008, while serving in Mosul, Iraq.
