BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of Interstate Route 670 in the municipal corporation of Columbus in Franklin County, running in an easterly and westerly direction between Fourth Street and Interstate Route 70, as the "Dana G. 'Buck' Rinehart Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Dana "Buck" Rinehart served as mayor of Columbus from 1984 to 1992.
