CONTENT AND OPERATION

Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools license plate

The bill creates the following license plate (R.C. 4503.873):

Special License Plate	Brecksville-Broadview Heights City Schools license plate, inscribed with the words and markings selected by the Brecksville-Broadview Heights City School District.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, motorcycle, cab-enclosed motorcycle, commercial motor vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, and, effective January 1, 2017, any motor-driven cycle or motor scooter.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$30 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the Brecksville-Broadview Heights City School District to provide services to the District's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students (<i>R.C. 4501.21</i>). The services may include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The District may hire charitable (501(c)(3)) organizations to provide services or may pay for faculty members to receive training in providing the services.

	The District is prohibited from using the contributions it receives for any purpose other than providing the services specified above.
Requirements for Issuance	(1) Submission of an application; (2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; (3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates do not apply.
