BILL SUMMARY

- Makes an appropriation from the GRF to be used by school districts for school safety purposes.
- Requires the State Board of Education to establish criteria and procedures for the awarding of these funds to school districts.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill appropriates an amount from the GRF to be distributed to school districts for school safety purposes. A school district is to apply for such assistance on an application form prescribed by the State Board of Education. The State Board of Education must establish procedures for the consideration and approval of applications and criteria for awarding funds.

Upon approval of an application, the funds are to be distributed on the basis of student enrollment, as follows:

SCHOOL DISTRICT ENROLLMENT	ANNUAL GRANT AMOUNT
Fewer than 1,000	Up to \$25,000
Between 1,000 and 2,000	Up to \$50,000
Greater than 2,000 but fewer than 10,000	Up to \$75,000
10,000 or more	Up to \$100,000
