BILL SUMMARY

The bill designates the following roadway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway:

Designated Name	Roadway
The "Lance Cpl. Eric J. Bernholtz Memorial Highway" ¹	A portion of S.R. 62, commencing at the intersection of S.R. 62 and Southwest Boulevard and proceeding in a southwesterly direction to the intersection of S.R. 62 and Kingston Avenue in Franklin County.

COMMENT

Lance Cpl. Eric J. Bernholtz died on August 3, 2005, when his amphibious assault vehicle was attacked by an improvised explosive device while he was conducting combat operations south of Hadithah, Iraq.
