CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Pancreatic Cancer Awareness" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:1

Special License Plate	Pancreatic Cancer Awareness license plate, which bears words and markings that promote pancreatic cancer awareness and are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution and Additional BMV Fee	\$25 required contribution.\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
Use of Contribution	Contributions must be used by the National Pancreatic Cancer Foundation to assist those who suffer with pancreatic cancer and their families. ²
Requirements for Issuance	 (1) Submission of an application; (2) Payment of the regular license tax, contribution, administrative fee, any applicable local tax, any applicable special reserved license plate fee; and

	(3) Compliance with all other applicable laws relating to motor vehicle registration.	
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.	
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
