BILL SUMMARY

- Provides the Ohio Department of Transportation with additional appropriations for highway construction and transit projects available to Ohio as a result of three sources of revenue received, or anticipated to be received, by the Department:
 - Federal funding as a result of Congressional passage of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act of 2015 (Pub. L No. 114.94);
 - Federal funding awarded under the TIGER Discretionary Grant Program operated by the U.S. Department of Transportation; and
 - Moneys authorized for ODOT from the sale of bonds issued by the Ohio Turnpike Commission.
- Declares an emergency.
