Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Passed by the House)	Sub. Version (LSC 131 1745-7)
Municipal garbage collection fees	Allows municipal corporations located in a charter county to certify garbage collection fees to the property tax list for collection in the same manner as property taxes (<i>R.C. 319.282</i>).	No provision.
Snow and ice removal from sidewalks	No provision.	Authorizes townships to require the removal of snow and ice from abutting sidewalks and to impose a fine for failure to do so (<i>R.C. 505.872</i>).
Community events in parks	No provision.	Authorizes boards of township trustees and boards of park commissioners to expend funds for the public purpose of presenting community events that are open to the public in their parks and at other recreational facilities (<i>R.C. 505.261, 511.23, and 755.13</i>).
Off-street parking for motor vehicles	No provision.	Authorizes a board of township trustees of an urban township to provide for off-street parking for motor vehicles (<i>R.C. 504.24 and 5709.10</i>).

Topic	Previous Version (As Passed by the House)	Sub. Version (LSC 131 1745-7)
Permit fees for driveway culverts or township highway excavations	No provision.	Allows townships to charge a fee of <i>up to</i> \$50 per application instead of the current fee of \$50 per application (<i>R.C. 5571.16</i>).
Request for hearing before township removal or repair of dangerous structures	No provision.	Reduces from 30 to 20 days the amount of time within which a party in interest must request a hearing before a board of township trustees removes, repairs, or secures dangerous buildings or structures (<i>R.C. 505.86</i>).
Reappointments of members of the Ohio Small Government Capital Improvements Commission	No provision.	Removes the current limitations on reappointments of members of the Ohio Small Government Capital Improvements Commission, allowing for unlimited reappointments (<i>R.C. 164.02</i>).
Intent statement regarding definition of "owner" in the Annexation Law	No provision.	Cites two cases as being contrary to the intent of the General Assembly regarding R.C. 709.02(E) (definition of "owner" for purposes of an annexation petition) (<i>Section 4</i>).

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
