### Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill prohibits, subject to certain exceptions, individuals who do not maintain satisfactory minimum levels of automobile insurance from collecting noneconomic damages for harm sustained in a motor vehicle accident. This provision will not generate additional cases for courts to dispose of, and conceivably could result in fewer such suits being filed. It is also possible that certain suits seeking damages may be disposed of more quickly than otherwise might have been the case under current law. The bill will not generate any additional costs for the courts and clerks of courts that handle these damages cases.
