CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates February 17 as "Annie Glenn Communication Disorders Awareness Day."¹

Annie Glenn, wife of former astronaut and U.S. Senator John Glenn, overcame a severe stuttering problem and has been recognized by the American Speech and Hearing Association for "providing an inspiring model for people with communicative disorders." She serves on the National Deafness and other Communication Disorders Advisory Council of the National Institutes of Health and is a member of the Advisory
