Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

5.2513 ~~_____~~ SECTION 1. That section ~~5.256~~ of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:

5.2513 ~~_____~~ Sec. ~~5.256~~ The month of April is designated as "Genocide Awareness Month" in remembrance of past atrocities and crimes of genocide and to increase awareness of such atrocities and crimes.

The section numbering of law of a general and permanent nature is complete and in conformity with the Revised Code. *
