#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Designates May 1 as "Fanconi Anemia Awareness Day."

#### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill designates May 1 as "Fanconi Anemia Awareness Day" in honor of those affected by this rare and debilitating genetic disease.1 Though considered primarily a blood disease, Fanconi anemia is characterized by multiple physical abnormalities, bone marrow failure, and a higher than normal risk of cancer.<sup>2</sup>
