BILL SUMMARY

- Provides the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) with \$150 million in appropriations in fiscal year 2017 and requires the funding to be distributed to political subdivisions for critical road maintenance repairs.
- To fund the appropriation, requires the Office of Budget and Management to transfer \$150 million from the Budget Stabilization Fund to the Road Maintenance Fund, which is created by the bill.
- Requires a political subdivision that receives project funding under the bill to provide funding for 50% of the project (ODOT will provide the remaining 50%).
