CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Sergeant James F. Allen III Memorial Highway" ¹	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route (SR) 261 between the intersection of that route with SR 94 and the intersection of that route and SR 21, in Medina and Summit Counties

COMMENT

Sergeant James F. Allen III was a decorated veteran who joined the Army two days after September 11, 2001, and deployed three times while serving in the military. He died in February of 2016, after losing his battle with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder.
