## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Staff Sergeant Paul C. Mardis Jr. Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of State Route 16, running in a northerly and southerly direction between the municipal corporation of Coshocton and Township Road 279, in Coshocton County.

Staff Sergeant Paul C. Mardis Jr. died July 15, 2004, from injuries sustained on May 20 of that year when his vehicle was struck by an improvised explosive device in Mosul, Iraq, while serving during Operation Iraqi Freedom.
