- Designates July 8 as "Harrison Dillard Day."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Designation	Harrison Dillard Day ¹
Honoree	Harrison Dillard, to commemorate the four-time Olympic champion's accomplishments in earning gold medals in the 1948 Summer Olympics (100-meter dash and 4x100-meter relay), and in the 1952 Summer Olympics (110-meter hurdles and 4x100-meter relay). ²
Date	July 8, the day Mr. Dillard was born in 1923.
